- a fossil fuel that is a gas
- collected from under the ground
- moved through pipelines
- used for home heating, manufacturing, and electricity generation

I am...

- a renewable energy source from heat within the Earth
- usually invisible but can be seen at volcanoes, hot springs, and geysers
- used to heat buildings and generate electricity

I am...

- the energy source that powers your lights and computers
- generated from a power plant
- stored in batteries
- always traveling in a circuit

- made from an ore found in the Earth
- turned into a fuel for nuclear power plants
