For 2024 and 2025, natural gas gross withdrawals have been estimated from data collected on Form EIA-914, *Monthly Crude Oil and Lease Condensate, and Natural Gas Production Report*.

For 2019-2023, volumes originally estimated from EIA-914 have typically been revised using data sourced from various state regulatory agencies and the Bureau of Safety and Environmental Enforcement (BSEE). Commercial data sources may also have been used for revision purposes (e.g., Enverus, S&P Global).
