

Highlights

U.S. crude oil refinery inputs averaged over 16.4 million barrels per day during the week ending April 1, 2016, 199,000 barrels per day more than the previous week's average. Refineries operated at 91.4% of their operable capacity last week. Gasoline production increased last week, averaging over 9.6 million barrels per day. Distillate fuel production decreased last week, averaging over 4.8 million barrels per day.

U.S. crude oil imports averaged about 7.3 million barrels per day last week, down by 494,000 barrels per day from the previous week. Over the last four weeks, crude oil imports averaged about 7.8 million barrels per day, 2.1% above the same four-week period last year. Total motor gasoline imports (including both finished gasoline and gasoline blending components) last week averaged 671,000 barrels per day. Distillate fuel imports averaged 62,000 barrels per day last week.

U.S. commercial crude oil inventories (excluding those in the Strategic Petroleum Reserve) decreased by 4.9 million barrels from the previous week. At 529.9 million barrels, U.S. crude oil inventories are at historically high levels for this time of year. Total motor gasoline inventories increased by 1.4 million barrels last week, and are well above the upper limit of the average range. Both finished gasoline inventories and blending components inventories increased last week. Distillate fuel inventories increased by 1.8 million barrels last week and are above the upper limit of the average range for this time of year. Propane/propylene inventories rose 2.0 million barrels last week and are above the upper limit of the average range. Total commercial petroleum inventories

increased by 1.1 million barrels last week.

Total products supplied over the last four-week period averaged 19.5 million barrels per day, up by 1.5% from the same period last year. Over the last four weeks, motor gasoline product supplied averaged about 9.4 million barrels per day, up by 4.2% from the same period last year. Distillate fuel product supplied averaged about 3.7 million barrels per day over the last four weeks, down by 6.8% from the same period last year. Jet fuel product supplied is down 3.1% compared to the same four-week period last year.

The WTI price was \$35.36 per barrel on April 1, 2016. The spot price for conventional gasoline in the New York Harbor was \$1.321 per gallon. The spot price for ultra-low sulfur diesel fuel in the New York Harbor was \$1.134 per gallon.

The national average retail regular gasoline price increased for the seventh week in a row to \$2.083 per gallon on April 4, 2016, \$0.017 over last week's price but \$0.330 under a year ago. The national average retail diesel fuel price decreased to \$2.115 per gallon, \$0.006 per gallon less than last week and \$0.669 below a year ago.
