Residential heating oil price decreases

The average retail price for home heating oil fell 3.6 cents from last week to \$4.09 per gallon. That's down 14.2 cents from a year ago, based on the residential heating fuel survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration. Heating oil prices in the New England region are at \$4.10 per gallon, down 2.4 cents from last week, and down 7.6 cents from a year ago.
