U.S. gasoline prices at its lowest since February 2011 (short version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline fell 7.1 cents from a week ago to \$3.19 a gallon on Monday. That's the lowest national pump price since February 2011, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.
