GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Purpose of the Survey

The Commercial Buildings Energy Consumption Survey (CBECS) collects data every 3 years on energy consumption, expenditures, and usage patterns for the nonresidential buildings sector of the U.S. economy. The information collected on the CBECS will be used to publish aggregate statistics on (1) the consumption and expenditures of energy by different types of buildings and (2) other consumption-related issues.

Purpose of this Form

The purpose of this reporting form is to obtain information on total district heating consumption for the **building** identified on the label on the front cover of this folder. The consumption to be reported is the total amount delivered to the building from December 1, 1994 through January 31, 1996.

If there are separately billed customers or separately maintained accounts in the building, the total should include the sum of all such separate customers or accounts, as well as any former customers or accounts that were active during the reporting period. The total should also include deliveries to all customers, or accounts in the building (during the reporting period), whether commercial or noncommercial.

If separately metered consumption information is not available for this building, please give us your best estimate.

Confidentiality

Any information collected that will permit identification of respondents or their buildings will be confidential and used only for statistical purposes. Data that can be identified with individual respondents will not be disclosed or released by Westat, Inc. to anyone (including the Department of Energy) for any other purpose, except as required by law.

If you are concerned about your individual account information, you may choose to mark out the account number or name on any computer-generated listing that you send us. EIA only requests the information required to complete this form for the building.

Data Collection Authority and Sanctions

This report is mandatory under Public Law 93-275, as amended. The timely submission of Form EIA-871D by those required to report is mandatory under Section 13 (b) of the Federal Energy Administration Act of 1974 (FEAA) (Public Law 93-275), as amended. Failure to respond may result in a civil penalty of not more than \$2,500 for each violation, or a fine of not more than \$5,000 for each willful violation. The government may bring a civil action to prohibit reporting violations that may result in a temporary restraining order or a preliminary or permanent injunction without bond. In such civil action, the court may also issue mandatory injunctions commanding any person to comply with these reporting requirements.

Reporting Media

Data may be submitted directly on the reporting form inside this folder, or in any other format, such as a computer-generated listing, which provides <u>all</u> the information requested (Items 1 through 7) and is convenient for your company. If a company format is used, please indicate where each piece of requested information is listed on the provided format.

You may submit one report for the entire building, or if it is easier, one report for each of several accounts in the building and EIA's survey contractor (Westat) will create an aggregated record for the building.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR SPECIFIC ITEMS

Definition of "Customer"

The term "customer" refers to a company, office, person, agency, etc., that is sent a bill or statement for energy supplied to the building, regardless of whether the bills or statements are sent to the building address or to some other address. The term also includes any separate bill or statement sent to the building management or owners for the costs of energy supplied to the building as a whole (hallways, lobbies, areas used for storage or maintenance operations, etc.). Sometimes buildings on a campus or other large facility receive steam from a central plant and do not receive bills or statements. This form requests information even for buildings that do not receive separate bills or statements, <u>i.e.</u>, have no "customers."

<u>Item 2</u>

In your answer to Item 2, specify whether the consumption information reported in Item 1 represents the consumption for more buildings than the building identified on the label. Check the YES box if the bills or statements that furnished the information for Item 1 show substantial consumption in buildings other than the selected one and you are unable to report separately for the selected building. Check the NO box if the bills show consumption in the selected building only. (Also check the NO box if the figures include minor out-buildings, such as a shed.)

<u>Item 3</u>

For each "YES" checked in Item 2, please report either:

- The estimated percentage of the reported quantity used by the building (3a); or
- The square footage of the building (3b.1) and the square footage of all buildings on the district loop (3b.2).

<u>Item 4</u>

Please indicate how you obtained the information provided in Question 1. If metered, indicate where the meter is located. The purpose of this question is to determine if the reported consumption includes transmission losses from the central plant to the building.

<u>Item 5</u>

The purpose of this question is to help explain unusual values reported in "Total Dollar Amounts." Sometimes buildings on a campus or other large facility receive steam from a central plant and are not billed individually. If this is the case, there may be no Total Dollar Amounts, or Total Dollar Amounts could be expected to be low compared to consumption.

<u>Item 6</u>

The purpose of this question is to help explain any extraordinary or unusual consumption. If the building identified on the label contains energy-conversion equipment used to produce energy to heat other buildings, it might help explain any unusually high consumption information reported for this building.

<u>Item 7</u>

Please provide the name, title, telephone number (including area code) and FAX number (if applicable) of the person who completed this form. This is the person we will contact if we have any questions about the completed form. Be sure to include the date of your response.
