



Total U.S. crude oil and petroleum product exports million barrels per day



The timing of export growth has varied across liquid fuels


Year-over-year change in crude oil and petroleum product exports thousand barrels per day



Aside from Canada, Asia and Europe are top destinations for U.S. crude exports


U.S. crude oil destinations (2017) thousand barrels per day




Distillate exports have averaged more than 1 million b/d since 2012

Gasoline exports are primarily sent to Mexico


