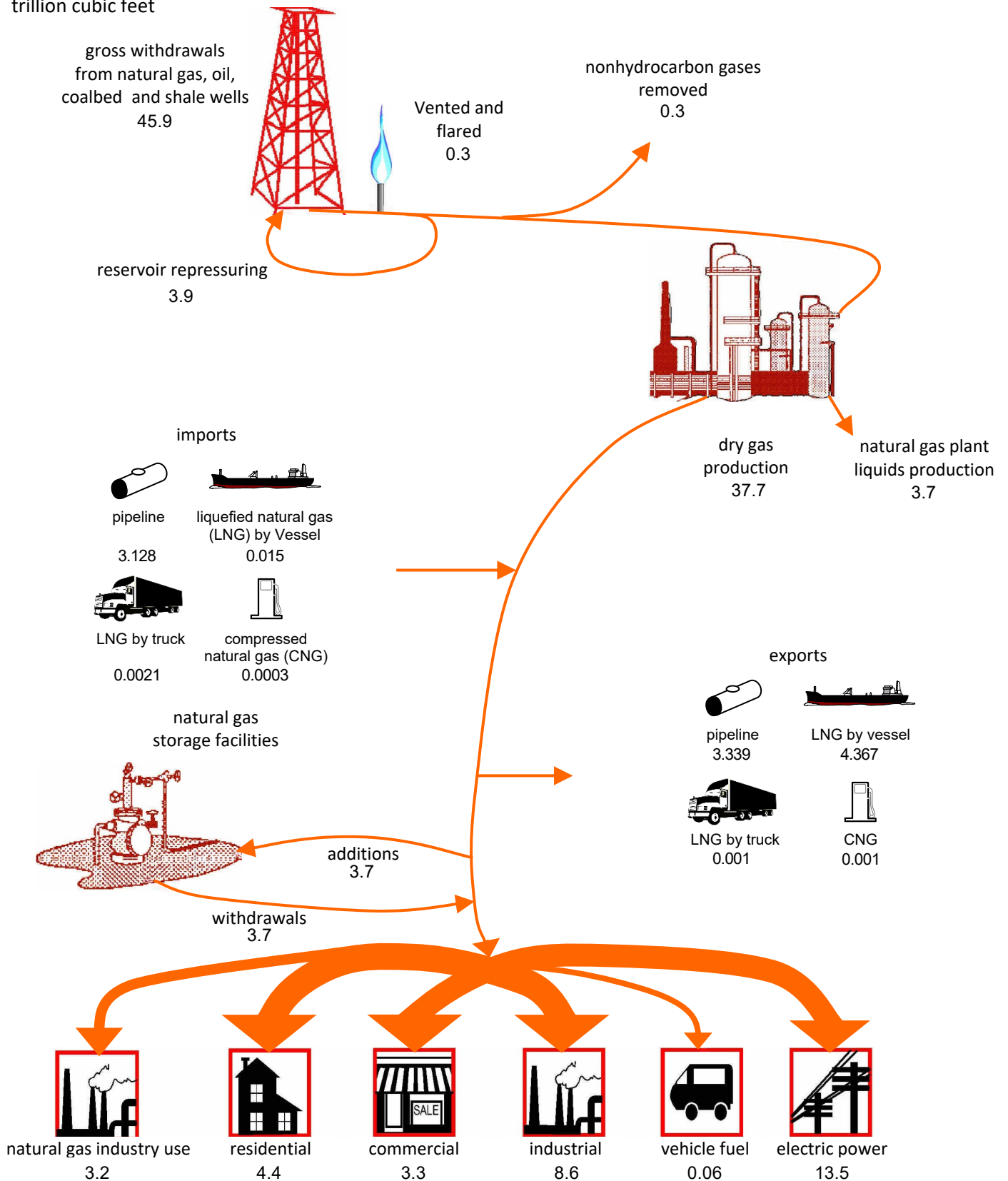


Figure 2. Natural gas supply and disposition in the United States, 2024
