**Notes:** For 2017 and 2018, natural gas production represents monthly natural gas gross withdrawals estimated from data collected on the EIA-914 report. Volumes through 2016 reflect EIA's final reported state data. Data for Arkansas, California, Colorado, Kansas, Louisiana, Montana, New Mexico, North Dakota, Ohio, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, Texas, Utah, West Virginia, Wyoming, and Federal Offshore Gulf of Mexico are individually collected on the EIA-914 report. The "Other States" category comprises states/areas that are not individually collected on the EIA-914 report (Alabama, Arizona, Federal Offshore Pacific, Florida, Idaho, Illinois, Indiana, Kentucky, Maryland, Michigan, Mississippi, Missouri, Nebraska, Nevada, New York, Oregon, South Dakota, Tennessee, and Virginia). Before 2017, Federal Offshore Pacific is included in California. All data for Alaska are obtained directly from the state. Data for 2017 and 2018 are estimated. The sum of individual states may not equal total U.S. volumes due to independent rounding. Previous months' production volumes may have been revised for all states/areas.
