Notes: For 2017, natural gas production represents monthly natural gas gross withdrawals estimated from data collected on the EIA-914 survey. Volumes through 2016 reflect EIA's final reported state data. Data for Arkansas, California, Colorado, Kansas, Louisiana, Montana, New Mexico, North Dakota, Ohio, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, Texas, Utah, West Virginia, Wyoming, and Federal Offshore Gulf of Mexico are individually collected on the EIA-914 survey. The "Other States" category comprises states/areas not individually collected on the EIA-914 survey (prior to 2015, that includes Alabama, Arizona, Arkansas, California, Colorado, Federal Offshore Pacific, Florida, Illinois, Indiana, Kansas, Kentucky, Maryland, Michigan, Mississippi, Missouri, Montana, Nebraska, Nevada, New York, North Dakota, Ohio, Oregon, Pennsylvania, South Dakota, Tennessee, Utah, West Virginia, and Virginia; starting in 2015, "Other States" includes Alabama, Arizona, Federal Offshore Pacific, Florida, Idaho, Illinois, Indiana, Kentucky, Maryland, Michigan, Mississippi, Missouri, Nebraska, Nevada, New York, Oregon, South Dakota, Tennessee, and Virginia). Before 2017, Federal Offshore Pacific is included in California. All data for Alaska are obtained directly from the state. Data for 2017 are estimated. The sum of individual states may not equal total U.S. volumes due to independent rounding. Previous months' production volumes may have been revised for all states/areas.
