

# Highlights

U.S. crude oil refinery inputs averaged 15.9 million barrels per day during the week ending February 3, 2017, 54,000 barrels per day less than the previous week's average. Refineries operated at 87.7% of their operable capacity last week. Gasoline production increased last week, averaging 9.8 million barrels per day. Distillate fuel production increased last week, averaging 4.8 million barrels per day.

U.S. crude oil imports averaged about 9.4 million barrels per day last week, up by 1.1 million barrels per day from the previous week. Over the last four weeks, crude oil imports averaged about 8.5 million barrels per day, 10.0% above the same four-week period last year. Total motor gasoline imports (including both finished gasoline and gasoline blending components) last week averaged 811,000 barrels per day. Distillate fuel imports averaged 209,000 barrels per day last week.

U.S. commercial crude oil inventories (excluding those in the Strategic Petroleum Reserve) increased by 13.8 million barrels from the previous week. At 508.6 million barrels, U.S. crude oil inventories are above the upper limit of the average range for this time of year. Total motor gasoline inventories decreased by 0.9 million barrels last week, but are above the upper limit of the average range. Both finished gasoline inventories and blending components inventories decreased last week. Distillate fuel inventories remained unchanged last week and are above the upper limit of the average range for this time of year. Propane/propylene inventories fell 6.9 million barrels last week but are in the middle of the average range. Total commercial petroleum inventories increased by 1.4 million

barrels last week.

Total products supplied over the last four-week period averaged about 19.9 million barrels per day, up by 0.3% from the same period last year. Over the last four weeks, motor gasoline product supplied averaged over 8.3 million barrels per day, down by 6.0% from the same period last year. Distillate fuel product supplied averaged about 3.9 million barrels per day over the last four weeks, up by 7.6% from the same period last year. Jet fuel product supplied is up 6.4% compared to the same four-week period last year.

The WTI price was \$53.81 per barrel on February 3, 2017, \$0.63 over last week's price and \$22.95 above a year ago. The spot price for conventional gasoline in the New York Harbor was \$1.561 per gallon, \$0.005 more than last week's price and \$0.536 higher than a year ago. The spot price for No. 2 heating oil in the New York Harbor was \$1.572 per gallon, \$0.053 above last week's price and \$0.598 over a year ago.

The national average retail regular gasoline price decreased for the fourth week in a row to \$2.293 per gallon on February 6, 2017, \$0.003 less than last week's price but \$0.534 more than a year ago. The national average retail diesel fuel price decreased for the fourth week in a row to \$2.558 per gallon, \$0.004 per gallon under last week but \$0.550 over a year ago.
