



U.S. diesel fuel price decreases

The U.S. average retail price for on-highway diesel fuel fell to \$4.55 a gallon on Monday. That's down 3.4 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Diesel prices were highest in the West Coast states at \$5.08 a gallon, down 1.1 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast region at \$4.22 a gallon, down 4.4 cents.
