U.S. diesel fuel prices increase

The U.S. average retail price for on-highway diesel fuel rose to \$2.74 a gallon on Monday. That's up 2.2 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Diesel prices were highest in the West Coast states, at \$3.20 a gallon, up 2.3 cents from last week. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast region at \$2.50 a gallon, up 1.7 cents from a week ago.
