U.S. diesel fuel prices increase

The U.S. average retail price for on-highway diesel fuel rose to \$3.26 a gallon on Monday. That's up 2-tenths of a penny from a week ago based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Diesel prices were highest in the West Coast states, at \$3.76 a gallon, up 1.1 cents from last week. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast region at \$3.03 a gallon, down 2-tenths of a penny from a week ago.
