U.S. diesel fuel prices continue to decrease

The U.S. average retail price for on-highway diesel fuel fell to \$3.04 a gallon on Monday. That's down 2.7 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Diesel prices were highest in the West Coast states at 3.63 a gallon, down 3.5 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast states at 2.80 a gallon, down 2.3 cents.
