U.S. diesel fuel prices increase

The U.S. average retail price for on-highway diesel fuel rose to \$3.34 a gallon on Monday. That's up 7-tenths of a penny from a week ago based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Diesel prices were highest in the West Coast states, at \$3.59 a gallon, up 7.8 cents from last week. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast region at \$3.08 a gallon, up 7-tenths of a penny from a week ago.
