U.S. diesel fuel prices decrease

The U.S. average retail price for on-highway diesel fuel fell to \$2.44 a gallon on Monday. That's down six tenths of a penny from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Diesel prices were highest in the West Coast states, at \$2.96 a gallon, down 8 tenths of a penny from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast region at \$2.18 a gallon, down four tenths of a penny.
