U.S. diesel fuel prices decrease

The U.S. average retail price for on-highway diesel fuel fell to \$3.37 a gallon on Monday. That's down 1-tenth of a penny from a week ago based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Diesel prices were highest in the West Coast states, at \$4.02 a gallon, down 4-tenths of a penny from last week. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast region at \$3.10 a gallon, down 5-tenths of a penny from a week ago.
