U.S. diesel fuel prices increase

The U.S. average retail price for on-highway diesel fuel rose to \$3.73 a gallon on Monday. That's up 4 tenths of a penny from a week ago based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Diesel prices were highest in the West Coast region, at \$4.42 a gallon, up .05 from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast region at \$3.47 a gallon, down 8 tenths of a penny from a week ago.
