

U.S. gasoline prices increase (long version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline rose to \$2.25 a gallon on Monday. That's up 6-tenths of a penny from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast states at \$2.81 a gallon, up 1.5 cents from last week. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast states at \$1.93 a gallon, seeing no movement from last week.
