## **U.S. gasoline price continues to decrease (long version)**

---

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline fell to \$2.24 a gallon on Monday. That's down 2.9 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast states at 3.01 a gallon, down 4.1 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast region at 1.89 a gallon, down 4 cents.
