



U.S. gasoline price increases (long version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline increased to \$3.26 a gallon on Monday. That's up 3.6 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast states at \$3.96 a gallon, up 2.2 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast region at \$2.89 a gallon, down 0.1 cents.
