



## **U.S. gasoline price decreases (long version)**

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline decreased to \$3.10 a gallon on Monday. That's down 6 tenths of a cent from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast states at \$3.88 a gallon, up 1 cent from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast region at \$2.70 a gallon, up one half of a cent from a week ago.
