



U.S. gasoline price increases (long version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline increased to \$3.10 a gallon on Monday. That's up 3.3 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast states at \$3.94 a gallon, up 1.1 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Rocky Mountain region at \$2.73 a gallon, up 6.1 cents from a week ago.
