U.S. gasoline prices increase (long version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline rose to \$2.41 gallon on Monday. That's up 1.7 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast states at \$2.96 a gallon, up 2.4 cents from last week. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast states at \$2.11 a gallon, up five tenths of a penny from last week.
