U.S. gasoline price decreases (long version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline fell to \$2.25 a gallon on Monday. That's down 2 tenths of a penny from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast states at 2.91 a gallon, down 1.6 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast region at 1.93 a gallon, down 2.8 cents.
