U.S. gasoline price decreases (long version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline rose to \$2.28 a gallon on Monday. That's up 2.2 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast states at 2.92 a gallon, up 9 tenths of a penny from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast region at 1.96 a gallon, up 2.8 cents.
