

U.S. gasoline prices increase (long version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline rose to \$2.50 gallon on Monday. That's up 4.0 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast states at \$3.04 a gallon, up 4.2 cents from last week. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast states at \$2.22 a gallon, down 5.3 cents from last week.
