## **U.S. gasoline prices decrease (long version)**

---

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline fell to \$2.85 a gallon on Monday. That's down 8-tenths of a penny from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast states at \$3.51 a gallon, up 2 cents from last week. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast states at \$2.58 a gallon, down 1 cent from last week.
