U.S. gasoline prices increase (long version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline rose to \$2.89 a gallon on Monday. That's 1.8 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast states at \$3.60 a gallon, up 4.6 cents from last week. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast states at \$2.58 a gallon, down 3-tenths of a penny from last week.
