U.S. gasoline price continues to increase (long version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline rose to \$2.90 a gallon on Monday. That's up a penny from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast states at 3.71 a gallon, up 3.6 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast region at 2.56 a gallon, down 2 1/2 cents.
