## **U.S. gasoline price decreases for first time since early February (short version)**

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline fell for the first time in over three months to \$2.87 a gallon on Monday. That's down 3.1 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.
