## U.S. gasoline price decreases (long version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline decreased to \$3.61 a gallon on Monday. That's down 3.5 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast states at $\$ 4.69$ a gallon, down 6 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast region at $\$ 3.17$ a gallon, down 7.6 cents from a week ago.
