



U.S. gasoline price increases (long version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline increased to \$3.54 a gallon on Monday. That's up 0.3 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast states at \$4.52 a gallon, down 1.1 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast region at \$3.08 a gallon, up 3.4 cents from a week ago.
