U.S. gasoline prices increase (long version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline fell to \$3.02 a gallon on Monday. That's down 8 tenths of a penny from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast states at 3.70 a gallon, up 2.3 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast states at 2.75 a gallon, down 2.8 cents.
