U.S. gasoline prices increase (long version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline rose to \$3.03 a gallon on Monday. That's up 7-tenths of a penny from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast states at \$3.72 a gallon, up 2.6 cents from last week. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast states at \$2.72 a gallon, down 3.3 cents from last week.
