U.S. gasoline prices increase (long version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline fell to \$3.06 a gallon on Monday. That's down 9-tenths of a penny from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast states at \$3.76 a gallon, up 8-tenths of a penny from last week. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast states at \$2.73 a gallon, down 2.8 cents from last week.
