U.S. gasoline prices continue to decrease (long version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline fell to \$2.65 a gallon on Monday. That's down 1.6 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast states at 3.39 a gallon, down 6.3 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast region at 2.30 a gallon, down 3.7 cents.
