## **U.S. gasoline prices decrease (long version)**

---

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline fell to \$2.21 a gallon on Monday. That's down 1.1 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast states at \$2.86 a gallon, seeing no movement from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast states at \$1.89 a gallon, up one tenth of a penny.
