U.S. gasoline prices decrease (long version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline fell to \$3.17 a gallon on Monday. That's down 1.1 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast states at \$3.94 a gallon, up 2-tenths of a penny from last week. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast states at \$2.81 a gallon, down 1.3 cents from last week.
