U.S. gasoline prices decrease (long version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline fell to \$2.18 a gallon on Monday. That's down 2.8 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast states at \$2.86 a gallon, down 3 tenths of a penny from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast states at \$1.86 a gallon, down 3.3 cents.
