U.S. gasoline prices increase (long version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline rose to \$3.39 a gallon on Monday. That's up 7 tenths of a penny from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast states at 4.10 a gallon, up 3 1/2 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast states at 3.07 a gallon, up half a penny.
