

U.S. gasoline prices increase (long version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline rose to \$3.41 a gallon on Monday. That's up 2 from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast region at \$4.13 a gallon, up 2.5 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast states at \$3.10 a gallon, up 3.5 cents from a week ago.
