U.S. gasoline prices decrease (long version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline fell to \$3.40 a gallon on Monday. That's down .01 from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast region at \$4.17 a gallon, up .04 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast states at \$3.07 a gallon, down .03 cents from a week ago.
