



U.S. gasoline price decreases (long version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline fell to \$3.65 a gallon on Monday. That's down 11.4 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast states at \$4.78 a gallon, down 14.5 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast region at \$3.02 a gallon, down 11.6 cents.
