U.S. gasoline prices decreases (long version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline fell to \$3.40 a gallon on Monday. That's down 4 tenths of a penny from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast region at 4.19 a gallon, up 2.3 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast states at 3.03 a gallon, down 4.1 cents.
