Residential heating oil price decreases slightly

The average retail price for home heating oil fell 2-tenths of a cent from last week to \$3.18 per gallon. That's up 4.7 cents from a year ago, based on the residential heating fuel survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration. Heating oil prices in the New England region are at \$3.15 per gallon, down 3-tenths of a cent from last week, but up 4.6 cents from a year ago.
