



Residential heating oil price decreases

The average retail price for home heating oil fell 7.3 cents from last week to \$4.39 per gallon. That's up 43.4 cents from a year ago, based on the residential heating fuel survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration. Heating oil prices in the New England region are at \$4.34 per gallon, down 8.8 cents from last week, but up 41 cents from a year ago.
