



Residential heating oil price decreases

The average retail price for home heating oil fell 12.2 cents from last week to \$4.27 per gallon. That's up 31 cents from a year ago, based on the residential heating fuel survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration. Heating oil prices in the New England region are at \$4.20 per gallon, down 13.3 cents from last week, but up 28 and a half cents from a year ago.
