Residential heating oil price decreases

The average retail price for home heating oil fell 1 cent from last week to \$3.22 per gallon. That's up 16 cents from a year ago, based on the residential heating fuel survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration. Heating oil prices in the New England region are at \$3.18 per gallon, down half of a cent from last week, but up 15.3 cents from a year ago.
